

# Northumberland County Sheriff's Office

## 2021 Citizen's Report

### Calls

In 2021 the Northumberland County Sheriff's Office received **15713 calls for service** into our dispatch center. **Down 10%** from last year.

Of those calls for service **13669** required a **Law Enforcement Officer Response. (just under 38 per day)**

1595 required an EMS response

316 required a Fire Department response

### Investigations

From those responses **589 Criminal Investigation Reports** were completed. **Up 3.5 %** from last year. Not counting "information only" reports we show a **(74.3% clearance rate)** with many investigations still pending.

### Arrests

**319 Arrests (Same** as last year) were made.

With **572 Warrants Served. (Down 7%** from last year) (183 Felonies, 273 Misdemeanors, 116 Summons/Capias)

#### **Demographic breakdown of arrests:**

White- 184

African American-135

Other -0

Male- 238      Female- 81

\*\*\*NOTE: 50 of these arrests were on warrants from other jurisdictions

### **Civil Process**

This office served **3185 Civil Papers** during the year. **Up 4.9%** from last year.

### **Traffic**

Our deputies made **690 Traffic Stops (Down 55%** from last year) resulting in **332 Traffic Citations (Down 40%** from last year)

\*\*\*NOTE: This decrease can be attributed to losing a DMV grant which previously paid for a lot of overtime traffic work.

### **Demographic breakdown of Traffic Citations issued:**

White- 210

African American- 116

Other-28

Male 217 , Female 115

**21 DUI Arrest** were made. This number is **Down 38.2%** from last year.

We responded to **233 Traffic Accidents. Down 12.4%** from last year

## Community

COVID-19 restrictions continued to subdue our community involvement efforts

Along with community members we formed a **Community Liaison and Advisory Council** where members and deputies participate in discussions and trainings to better understand each other.

Our office was able to hold **3 Community Events** earlier in the year with approximately **200 Attendees**.

The Sheriff or his designee gave **8 Crime Prevention Presentations** to various groups throughout the county.

Our School Resource Officers **DARE** program never got off the ground in 2021 due to COVID-19.

**17 Northumberland High School students** participated in the **Explorers Program** run by our office.
