HOW IT WORKS:

Once a person is enrolled in the "Safe & Secure" program, they will communicate twice daily with the Northumberland County Sheriff's Office. The communication usually consists of one phone call in the morning and one in the afternoon. If the person cannot be contacted, a Deputy will be dispatched to the residence to check on the person's welfare. The Northumberland County Sheriff's Office has developed the "Safe & Secure" program to facilitate ongoing independent living while promoting a sense of community, welfare, and security through daily communications with those in need.

ENROLLMENT:

While the program is primarily designed to assist senior citizens, any resident of Northumberland County is eligible to apply to the "Safe & Secure" program. Once application is made, the program director will arrange for an interview and home visit. During the visit, the applicant will be asked to complete a personal data form to include health history, next-of-kin, family doctor, and so forth. Photographs of the person are taken. Arrangements are made for Law Enforcement officers to enter the residence in the event the person cannot otherwise be contacted.
